III. Result of the IPARD II meeting

In accordance with the point 1 of the Agenda: Opening of the meeting, Adoption of the Agenda

- Đuro Žugić, State Secretary of the Ministry and Chairperson of the IPARD II MC opened the meeting and presented the Agenda. By reading the names of members from the list, it has been found that a sufficient number of members are present and the quorum is met.

Decision number 1

- Agenda was adopted.
- All 20 members with voting rights voted YES for the adoption.

In accordance with the point 2 of the Agenda: Short introduction by European Commission (DG AGRI), Liam Breslin, Head of Unit - Pre-accession assistance DG AGRI.E5

The overview of the main conclusion of the discussion:

- Liam Breslin, Head of Unit - Pre-accession assistance DG AGRI.E5 praised the current work of the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, emphasizing the great pleasure as the implementation of the IPARD II program is started. He said that a good information campaign was conducted, through which the agricultural producers got all the necessary information, and that it is important to continue with it, so that the entire process, until the allocation of support, will be done in the right way. He took the opportunity to introduce the participants to the new Common Agricultural Policy under preparation, and through which greater emphasis will be placed on environmental issues and the strengthening of young farmers and putting the ceilings for direct payments to farmers.


In accordance with the point 3 of the Agenda: Adoption of the minutes of the previous IPARD monitoring committee (MC) meeting (attached to the agenda) and information on the implementation of decisions taken at the previous IPARD II monitoring committee meeting

The overview of the main conclusion of the discussion:

- Đuro Žugić, State Secretary of the Ministry and Chairperson
The Minutes were sent to all members of the IPARD II Monitoring Committee within the foreseen deadline. There were no comments on the minutes in question. The only decision was to establish an IPARD website, which was implemented.

Decision number 2

- Minutes from the previous meeting of IPARD II MC were approved.
- All 20 members with voting rights voted YES for the adoption.

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In accordance with the point 4 of the Agenda: State of play of the implementation of the IPARD II programme


The overview of the main conclusion of the discussion:

- **Darko Konjević, Director General of Directorate for Rural Development**, reminded the participants that the implementation of the IPARD II program started, with two public calls that have already been announced, that an intensive information campaign has been launched since the process of getting entrustment of the management of EU funds is received. Public call for Measure 1 "Investments in Physical Assets of Agricultural Holdings" was closed for application on May 15th, 2018, while interested potential applicants their application through a public call for Measure 3 "Investments in physical assets concerning processing and marketing of agricultural and fishery products" can submit to the Ministry by July 16th, 2018. He recalled the 39 million available support funds, pointing out that the withdrawal of funds would depend on how much money is "spent", so the amount can be bigger and smaller.

In accordance with the point 5 of the Agenda: Presentation of the FIRST IPARD call for Measure 1 (General information about programme/measure implementation on the basis of monitoring tables & results of calls; Report of approved/rejected projects)

The overview of the main conclusion of the discussion:

- **Blagota Radulović, Director General of Directorate for Payments**, presented the results of the first IPARD public call for the investments in physical assets in agricultural holdings, highlighting the great satisfaction with the number of received applications. The 389 applications received are the best indicators, both for the information campaigns that have been conducted and for the agricultural producers themselves to modernize their farms. For comparison, he pointed out that in Macedonia, for the 3 public calls announced 140 applications were received, in Croatia, 2 public calls were announced 40 applications were received and in Turkey 3 public calls were announced and only 10 applications were received. He noted that in the next 5-6 public calls the situation in the number of applications in these countries did not improve much, and in total within the IPARD I programming period for these countries, Macedonia has published 12, Croatia 21, and Turkey 15 public calls. He recalled the significant experience that, both producers and institutions, got through the implementation of the IPARD like and MIDAS project. He reminded that 10 million support was given for the announced public call, while at the moment, it amounts to a potential 16 millions of support. He pointed out that the results of this public call will be used to rank applications, which will usually be done after the first release, which is a specific situation. The largest number of applications are from the northern region (221 applications or 56.81%), followed by the Central region (145 applications or 37.27%) and the southern region (23 applications, or 5.92%). What is pointed out, and as a reflection of the current development, is that the requested amount of investments is the largest in the central part of Montenegro, and this amount of investments is 11.701.175,12 EUR excluding VAT, in the northern part 11,147,914.21 EUR, while in

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the southern part this amount is the lowest and amounts to 1,988,986.53 EUR, also without VAT. When it comes to the type of investments, most applications are related to the purchase of agricultural mechanization, 187 applications or 48.07%, then to the purchase of equipment and mechanization 80 applications, or 20.56%, mixed investment (construction, procurement of equipment and mechanization, planting) 61 applications, or 15.68%, and 41 applications, or 11.42%, are exclusively for the construction of objects. He pointed out that from the presented data it can be noticed that the bulk of the investments are focused on the procurement of equipment that is, the modernization of production, and hopes that, through subsequent calls, a greater emphasis will be placed on the expansion of production. In the end he concluded that the involvement of all institutions is essential in order to implement the whole process as successful as possible.

Liam Breslin, Head of Unit - Pre-accession assistance DG AGRI

Question: Can you tell us which date could be indicative for signing the contract on granting support.

Blagota Radulović, Director General of Directorate for Payments

Answer: At this point we cannot answer that question. Through MIDAS and IPARD like projects it takes about 7 months. Certainly, all the institutions will make their contribution to do all necessary activities in the shortest possible period, but it is certainly important to note that the procedures are quite clear and demanding, that there are a number of controls, and of course the specific field infrastructure in Montenegro must also be taken into account.

In accordance with the point 6 of the Agenda: Presentation of the FIRST IPARD call for Measure 3

The overview of the main conclusion of the discussion:

- **Blagota Radulović, Director General of Directorate for Payments**, reminded that the public call is in progress. It is realistic that a much smaller number of applications are expected than the public call for Measure 1, precisely because of the definition of the recipients by the public call, as well as the amount of investment.

In accordance with point 7 of the Agenda: Information on financial implementation of IPARD, including use of interest earned (NAO); Management declaration

The overview of the main conclusion of the discussion:

- **Ivana Maksimović, Director General of the Directorate for Management Structure in Ministry of finance**, informed the participants that there were still no financial transactions since public calls have been just been published. The NAO in accordance with the procedures, opened a separate account, through the Central Bank. She pointed out that a Self-Assessment Questionnaire was used and that the Management Declaration was sent to DG AGRI within the deadline of February 15, 2018.



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In accordance with the point 8 of Agenda: Information about the communication activities linked to the 'Plan of visibility and communication activities for IPARD II programme' for the period 2017-2018; Presentation of the IPARD website; Approval of the update of the 'Plan of visibility and communication activities - Annual List of Actions – 2018'

The overview of the main conclusion of the discussion:

- **Ana Čabarkapa, Advisor for coordination and public relations of rural development**, presented an information campaign that was conducted from obtaining the entrustment. A series of press conferences were organized to mark important events (obtaining entrustment, publishing public calls for measure 1 and measure 3). The conferences were attended by representatives of the Delegation of the European Union in Montenegro, associations, as well as institutions involved in the implementation of the IPARD II program. In accordance with the published public calls, information workshops were conducted in almost all Montenegrin municipalities. In order to promote the FIRST IPARD Public Call for Measure 1, 22 workshops were organized, attended by 877 potential applicants for support, while 9 workshops were held for the promotion of the FIRST IPARD Public Call for Measure 3, attended by 79 potential applicants for support. For the promotion of both published public calls, 31 workshops were realized, attended by nearly 1000 (956) potential applicants. Announcement for the media was prepared for each of the mentioned workshops, and each was followed by a press release. Both the announcements and the press release were sent to all media in Montenegro. They are also posted on the MARD website, as well as on the IPARD website and on the official Facebook page of the MARD. During the workshops brief information about the workshop as well as what agricultural producers are particularly interested in at the workshops were posted on the Facebook. Each public call was published in the Official Gazette of Montenegro, as well as in 2 printed media. Immediately after publishing, through e-mail all municipalities were informed of the publication of the Public call. 1,000 copies of the guidelines for beneficiaries, leaflets for procurement procedures and leaflets for standards were printed. As mentioned above, since the moment when Montenegro got entrustment to manage the EU funds and officially informed the public through a press conference on November 10th, 2017, a more intense campaign for the promotion was launched. So far, the IPARD has been mentioned in a total of 119 newspaper articles, through 38 TV reports and through 181 posts on the portals. The IPARD website (www.ipard.gov.me) was presented, where it was emphasized that the same was established in a way that it was simple and transparent, where on the title page there are always current and most important information. All necessary documentation, as well as contact details can be found on the IPARD website.

Liam Breslin, Head of Unit - Pre-accession assistance DG AGRI

Question: Can you tell us from the perspective of the producers whether the information campaign was successful.

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Milko Živković, President, Union of livestock producers of north of Montenegro

Answer: The information campaign was comprehensive and extremely clear to those who were interested. It is suggested that a greater emphasis should be placed on field work by staff in the MARD and local self-governments, in order to get information to the farmers in remote areas, as there are still a significant number of agricultural producers who do not have access to the Internet.

Ratko Bataković, President, Network for Rural Development of Montenegro

Answer: The information campaign was intense. The Rural Development Network has made its contribution through the promotion of available support measures. He presented a mobile office project, which can also be mounted in the most remote places and used to inform farmers about available support measures.

Vukota Stanišić, Head, Advisory service in plant production

Answer: The advisory services have done significant field work through daily communication with agricultural producers, as well as by visiting them. The fact is that field work would be even more intensive in the case of an increased number of staff in the advisory services. He pointed out that, in particular, in the municipality of Pljevlja in the next period, 2 more agricultural engineers, will be employed, which will further strengthen the information campaign through field work.

Liam Breslin, Head of Unit - Pre-accession assistance DG AGRI

Comment: Experience has shown that the best promotion is a positive example, that is, beneficiaries of IPARD II support who applied for public calls, received funding and improved agricultural production.

Ana Čabarkapa, Advisor for coordination and public relations of rural development

Answer: A section of the website has been dedicated to questions, and a document containing the most common questions and answers related to public calls for measures 1 and 3 has been set up on IPARD website.

It was pointed out that the Annual Activity List 2018 has been updated. - The Visibility Plan and communication activities for the IPARD II program have been sent to all members of the IPARD II Monitoring Committee for comments, and it is necessary to be adopted at the meeting.

Decision number 3

- The update of the 'Plan of visibility and communication activities - Annual List of Actions – 2018 is adopted.
- All 20 members with voting rights voted YES for the adoption.

In accordance with the point 10 of Agenda: Presentation of the 'Indicative annual action plan for the implementation of technical assistance activities'

The overview of the main conclusion of the discussion:



- **Darko Konjević, Director General of Directorate for Rural Development**, briefly presented the Indicative Annual Action Plan for the implementation of the technical assistance measure. He pointed out that from June 26 to 29, 2018, an expert will work with MARD employees on the improvement and finalization of the mentioned Plan, as well as the complete procedure for accreditation of the Technical Assistance measure.

In accordance with point 11 of Agenda: General state of play of the preparation of the other IPARD II measures (excluding the measures 1 and 3)

The overview of the main conclusion of the discussion:

- **Darko Konjević, Director General of Directorate for Rural Development**, said that the application for accreditation will be submitted in the following period for two measures of IPARD II program: Measure 7 - Diversification and business development and measures 9 - Technical assistance. He then clarified the above measures, emphasizing that the measure 9 - technical assistance is not visible to the agricultural producers themselves, but the support can be used to promote support measures through the IPARD II program, the development of various brochures, the organization of meetings of the IPARD II monitoring committees, and the like. Measure 7 - Diversification and business development will encompass the development of rural tourism, processing on the holding and crafts. He introduced the attendees with the obligation to have complete legal regulations in order to support these areas. All this implies that the IPARD II program will be modified in the upcoming period. He reminded that the proposed changes will be submitted to all members of the IPARD II Committee, which in accordance with the procedures for amending the IPARD II program must be adopted by the IPARD II Monitoring Committee.

In accordance with the point 12 of Agenda: Presentation of some of the members of the IPARD II monitoring committee

The overview of the main conclusion of the discussion:

- **Željko Macanović, President, NGO "Healthy grain", Pljevlja**
He presented the Association, saying that it currently has 6 members, but that there is an increasing interest of agricultural producers, and believes that by the end of the year it will have 10 members. Members of the association are engaged in the organic production of cereals. 2 members of the association used the support through the IPARD-like project, while one member applied for the first IPARD public call for the Measure 1. He pointed out that one of the problems in which the producers encountered the too long procedure of deciding on loan applications with the Investment Development Fund.
- **Rade Rajkovic, President, National Association of viticulturist and wine producers of Montenegro**
He presented an association that has been in existence for more than 10 years. It is constantly communicating with all its members and regularly informs them of all available support measures. It was pointed out that members of the association regularly exhibit their wines at fairs and win



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numerous awards and recognitions. A number of members also applied for the FIRST IPARD public call.

Liam Breslin, Head of Unit - Pre-accession assistance DG AGRI

Question: Is there interest in buying grain products?

Željko Macanović, President, NGO "Healthy grain", Pljevlja

Answer: There is a great interest in buying grain products, but, currently there is a limit on the quantity. They plan to increase the quantity of products with new and more modern mechanization, as well as taking additional land for lease. They sell their products in large part at fairs, both local and regional.

Liam Breslin, Head of Unit - Pre-accession assistance DG AGRI

Question: Where are the most needed investments in the wine and viticulture sector?

Rade Rajkovic, President, National Association of viticulturist and wine producers of Montenegro

Answer: The most needed investments are in the part of purchasing modern and modern equipment. It was emphasized that the land fragmentation is expressed.

Decision number 4

- At the next meeting, Association of olive and olive oil producers Bar and National Association of Beekeepers will be presented.
- All 20 members with voting rights voted YES for the adoption.

Jovan Nikolić, President, Monteorganika

Question: Will the new EU Common Agricultural Policy, in particular its amendments to the environmental protection, be binding, retroactive, for the beneficiaries of the IPARD II program, or public calls.

Liam Breslin, Head of Unit - Pre-accession assistance DG AGRI

Answer: It will not. Recipients of IPARD II support programs must be aligned with existing ones, while the new Agriculture and Rural Development Program will be developed in line with the new EU Common Agricultural Policy.

Comment: Attention was asked for 'small value chains' on which recently an IPARD conference was organized in Romania.

Milko Živković, President, Union of livestock producers of north of Montenegro

Comment: He praised the initiative to support and give emphasis to value chains, pointing out that the Union of livestock producers of north of Montenegro is also moving in that direction. It is necessary to find a model for stimulating agricultural producers for association. The biggest problem is the lack of capital for investments, stressing that the application procedure for IRF is extremely complicated and the proposal would be to establish a Guarantee Fund.



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Đuro Žugić, State Secretary of the Ministry and Chairperson of the IPARD II MC

Comment: The Investment development fund has decided to establish a Guarantee Fund, and it will be established in the following period.

Decision number 5

- At the next meeting, representatives of the Investment development fund will prepare a presentation of credit lines.
- All 20 members with voting rights voted YES for the adoption.

In accordance with the point 11 of Agenda: Proposals for a date and the agenda of the next meeting

The overview of the main conclusion of the discussion:
