The Trade Facilitation Agreement Facility (TFAF) is pleased to offer funding for one capital based government official to attend the formal session of the Committee on Trade Facilitation and additional workshops to be held at the WTO in Geneva, Switzerland, the week of 14 to 18 October 2019. In an effort to ensure more inclusive participation of Members in Committee work and Geneva activities, invitations have been extended to developing Members, however, priority will be given to LDCs and lower income countries.

The agenda of the Committee meeting will include notifications received since the last meeting and experience sharing on implementation of provisions of the TFA.
