The Montenegro has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of Climate Resilient Fisheries and Agrifood Sector Development Project (CRFASD), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Updating the LPIS Initial Layer Based on the New Digital Orthophoto Map.
2. The Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Water Management, through Technical Service Unit (TSU), now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Updating the LPIS Initial Layer Based on the New Digital Orthophoto Map, consisting of: reviewing the existing Initial Blocks; identifying and implementing all changes visible on the new DOF; aligning the boundaries of the Initial Blocks with the actual situation on the ground; updating land cover type information; updating information on ineligible areas; applying the pro-rata rules for pastures; improving the quality of the LPIS database and further aligning it with EU requirements. The total duration of the contract shall be 6 months from the date of contract signing.
3. Bidding will be conducted through National competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement in Investment Project Financing Goods, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services, February 2025 ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.

5. The bidding document in English may be purchased by interested Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below. A complete Set of Bidding Documents will be sent by e-mail, free of charge, after the providing the request on TSU e-mail address given below.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before October 15, 2026, 10,00h. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on October 15, 2026, 10,05h.
7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid-Securing Declaration.
8. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
