o potpisivanju Političke deklaracije o namjeri između Vlade Crne Gore i Vlade Republike Austrije, sa nacrtom Deklaracije

OPŠTE INFORMACIJE

U cilju podsticanja prijateljskih i partnerskih odnosa između Crne Gore i Republike Austrije, kako na političkom, tako i na ekonomskom planu, pokrenuta je zajednička inicijativa o potpisivanju Političke deklaracije o namjeri između Vlade Crne Gore i Vlade Republike Austrije (u daljem tekstu: Deklaracija). Potpisivanje Političke deklaracije o namjeri između Vlade Crne Gore i Vlade Republike Austrije bi bilo od izuzetne koristi za unapređenje međusobne saradnje. Deklaracijom se osigurava dodatno razumijevanje na najvišem političkom nivou, kao i jasno izražena namjera da se u narednom periodu intenzivira ekonomska saradnja kroz kontinuirani dijalog i zajedničke inicijative.

Vlada Republike Austrije je, u proteklom periodu, jasno pokazala spremnost da produbi saradnju sa Crnom Gorom u svim oblastima od zajedničkog interesa, što potvrđuju i posjete kancelara Štokera i ministarke vanjskih poslova Mejn-Rajzinger, svega pet mjeseci nakon formiranja nove austrijske vlade. Posebno je važna politička i ekspertska podrška Austrije evropskoj integraciji Crne Gore, u ključnom periodu koji je pred nama – sve do konačnog članstva u Evropskoj uniji, planiranog za 2028.

Potpisivanje Deklaracije je planirano prilikom posjete austrijskog kancelara Štokera Crnoj Gori, 12. avgusta 2025.

SVRHA SARADNJE

Imajući u vidu da je Republika Austrija prepoznata kao jedan od najvažnijih ekonomskih partnera Crne Gore, ali i kao snažan zagovornik politike proširenja i podržavalac članstva Crne Gore u Evropskoj uniji, prepoznamo značaj potpisivanja Deklaracije kao važnog koraka ka osnaživanju ekonomskih odnosa između Crne Gore i Republike Austrije.

Potpisivanjem ove Deklaracije, Vlada Crne Gore i Vlada Republike Austrije potvrđuju posvećenost i opredijeljenost da nastave jačanje partnerstva na temelju međusobnog povjerenja, zajedničkih ekonomskih interesa i evropskih vrijednosti. Očekuje se da će

uspostavljeni mehanizmi saradnje doprinijeti stvaranju konkretnih investicionih i razvojnih rezultata na obostranu korist.

OBLASTI SARADNJE

Deklaracija će poslužiti kao platforma za vođenje kontinuiranog ekonomskog dijaloga kroz ciljane aktivnosti:

- Informisanje i umrežavanje preduzeća zainteresovanih za uspostavljanje bilateralne saradnje;
- Organizacija bilateralnih poslovnih susreta (B2B) sa fokusom na ključne industrijske i ekonomske sektore: turizam, infrastruktura, energetika, saobraćaj i druge oblasti od zajedničkog interesa;
- Podsticanje aktivnijeg učešća austrijskih preduzeća koja posluju u Crnoj Gori, uz istovremenu promociju investicionih potencijala u cilju privlačenja novih investicija;
- Razmjena znanja, iskustava i dobrih praksi između relevantnih aktera iz javnog i privatnog sektora.

INSTITUCIONALNI OKVIR PORŠKE I IMPLEMENTACIJE

Koordinaciju aktivnosti, s crnogorske strane, vodiće Vlada Crne Gore, u saradnji sa resornim ministarstvima, državnim agencijama i poslovnim udruženjima.

Ispred Vlade Republike Austrije, nosilac aktivnosti biće Savezno ministarstvo za ekonomiju, energetiku i turizam, uz podršku Privredne komore Austrije (WKÖ) i Industrijske unije (IV).

Deklaracija ne predstavlja pravno obavezujući sporazum i ne stvara pravne ili finansijske obaveze prema nacionalnom ili međunarodnom pravu. Odnosno, predstavlja izraz zajedničke političke volje potpisanih strana da teže intenzivnoj bilateralnoj saradnji u oblasti ekonomije.

POLITICAL DECLARATION OF INTENT

on deepening Montenegrin-Austrian economic collaboration through structured dialogue and joint initiatives

between

The Government of Montenegro

represented by H.E. Mr. Miloško Spajić, Prime Minister of Montenegro

and

The Government of the Republic of Austria

represented by H.E. Mr. Christian Stocker, Federal Chancellor of the Republic of Austria

Podgorica, August 2025

I. Purpose

This Political Declaration of Intent reflects the mutual commitment of the Government of Montenegro and the Federal Chancellery of the Republic of Austria (hereinafter referred to as the "Sides") to deepen bilateral economic relations and to promote sustainable economic development in Montenegro and economic convergence in light of the anticipated integration into the European Single Market.

In particular, both Sides express their political will to institutionalize regular economic dialogue between Montenegrin and Austrian businesses, aimed at identifying strategic priority projects and facilitating strategic partnerships, investment cooperation, and knowledge exchange.

II. Framework of Cooperation

To this end, the Sides intend to:

Convene Montenegrin-Austrian Economic Roundtables at least once a year alternately in Montenegro and Austria starting in 2025, or held virtually as appropriate:

Ensure that these forums are platforms for:

- promoting increased awareness and mobilization within the Montenegrin and Austrian private and public sector to support economic cooperation through sustainable, innovative, and scalable business initiatives;
- presentations by Montenegrin and Austrian companies active or interested in bilateral cooperation;
- B2B meetings and thematic panels on key industrial and economic sectors, in particular (but not limited to) tourism and infrastructure, including energy and transportation;
- fostering the active engagement of Austrian companies already present in Montenegro, building on Austria's role as the eight-largest investor in Montenegro.

III. Implementation and Support Structure

The Sides decide that the Montenegrin-Austrian Economic Roundtables will take place under the patronage of the Austrian Federal Ministry of Economy, Energy and Tourism.

On the Montenegrin side, the Government of Montenegro will liaise with relevant ministries, government agencies and business associations to ensure broad and meaningful participation. The Austrian Federal Economic Chamber (Wirtschaftskammer Österreich, WKÖ) and the Federation of Austrian Industries (Industriellenvereinigung, IV) will act as strategic and implementing partners on the Austrian side.

IV. Nature of the Declaration

This Declaration does not constitute a legally binding agreement and does not give rise to legal or financial obligations under national or international law. Rather, it serves as an expression of the shared political will of the undersigned Sides to pursue intensified bilateral cooperation in the economic field.
