

REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) - Procurement of firefighting equipment– RFQ 01/26

Dear Sir / Madam:

We kindly request you to submit your quotation for RFQ 01-26 Procurement of firefighting equipment for the need of the project "Biodiversity Mainstreaming into Sectoral Policies and Practices and Strengthened Protection of Biodiversity Hot-Spots in Montenegro", as detailed in Annexes 1 and 1.1 of this RFQ. When preparing your quotation, please follow the instructions and information from sections 1 and 2.

Offers shall be reviewed based on completeness and compliance of the quotation with the minimum specifications described above and any other annexes providing details of Ministry requirements.

The quotation that complies with all of the specifications, requirements and offers the lowest price, as well as all other evaluation criteria indicated, shall be selected. Any offer that does not meet the requirements shall be rejected.

Any discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity) shall be re-computed by Ministry. The unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected. If the supplier does not accept the final price based on Ministry's re-computation and correction of errors, its quotation will be rejected.

At any time during the validity of the quotation, no price variation due to escalation, inflation, fluctuation in exchange rates, or any other market factors shall be accepted by Ministry after it has received the quotation. At the time of award of Contract, Ministry reserves the right to vary (increase or decrease) the quantity of services and/or goods, by up to a maximum twenty-five per cent (25%) of the total offer, without any change in the unit price or other terms and conditions.

Ministry is not bound to accept any quotation, nor award a contract, nor be responsible for any costs associated with a Supplier's preparation and submission of a quotation, regardless of the outcome or the manner of conducting the selection process.

Ministry's vendor protest procedure is intended to afford an opportunity to appeal for persons or firms not awarded a Purchase Order or Contract in a competitive procurement process. In the event that you believe you have not been fairly treated, you can send your appeal to Appeals commission which is working based on the UNDP rules, and implemented by Ministry of Tourism, Ecology, Sustainable development and Northern Region Development and, Government of Montenegro, you can communicate your vendor protest using the following email contact:
