**Women's Internship Program – Who Can Apply?**

This exclusive internship is open to female university students and recent graduates looking to gain hands-on experience in transport and infrastructure projects. The program is designed to help increase female participation in fields that have traditionally seen lower representation of women, such as engineering and construction.

**Eligibility Criteria:**

- **Education:** Final year of a full-time engineering program- transport or civil engineering (or recent postgraduate).
- **Language:** English (additional languages are a plus).
- **Technical Skills:** Familiarity with Microsoft Office, data analysis tools etc.

**Internship Structure:**

- Placement: Interns will work within the **Ministry of Transport of Montenegro** on TTFP-related activities.
- Mentorship: Interns will be paired with experienced mentors in the transport sector.
- Project Work: Practical tasks in data analysis, logistics, project management, and fieldwork.
- Training: Access to workshops and capacity building programs organized from the Ministry of transport and technical skills development.
- Duration: 12 months paid internship for a comprehensive learning experience.
- Number of candidates: 2 per year (3 years)
- Selected candidates will receive remuneration.
