## **Topic of the workshop BOTANICAL GLOSSARY**

Montenegrin set up strives toward multidisciplinary integration of results of contemporary ecological research and collaborative practices in the urban design and spatial planning. Theme of this year's exhibition of the Montenegrin Pavilion *EMERGING RESILIENCE*, set by **Sonja Radovic Jelovac**, the curator, is a framework for future research which will put focus on the need for a holistic approach through imperative of resilience of socio-ecological systems.

Workshop *BOTANICAL GLOSSARY* is conceptualised as the basis for creation of international multidisciplinary platform and applicable (applied) web application as the ultimate goal. By relying on the resilience theory as basic framework in creation of new resilient urban strategies, web application *BOTANICAL GLOSSARY* will also contain database of endemic plant species, their constitution, climate characteristics of the context and other characteristics from the aspect of adaptability, transformability and system self-organising.

The workshop will focus on seven carefully selected plant species from the territory of Montenegro the characteristics of which the students will first learn by examining prepared material.

The objective of the workshop is to open and debate issues on collaborative resilience, system approach in creating strategies in urban design, landscape urbanism, landscape architecture and urban planning which entail transdisciplinary collaboration on a smaller and larger spatial scale, from the aspect of other disciplines.

Possible outputs of workshop: conceptual map, conceptual model, manifesto, mini installation, collage and such.
