The assistance will be structured around three key components: (1) provision of support for effective management of EU programmes and projects in the environment and climate change sectors, including improvements in internal procedures, coordination, and communication mechanisms; (2) organization and delivery of capacity building activities such as on-the-job trainings, workshops, and study visits to enhance staff competences and performance; and (3) awareness-raising and communication activities related to the objectives and societal relevance of planned investments in key areas such as waste management, wastewater treatment, and circular economy. These efforts will help promote stakeholder engagement, build social consensus, and support public consultations at local, regional and national levels, in complementarity with broader EU visibility frameworks.
