## WTO REGIONAL ADVANCED COURSE ON TRADE NEGOTIATIONS SIMULATION SKILLS FOR CENTRAL AND EASTERN EUROPE, CENTRAL AND THE CAUCASUS COUNTRIES Vienna, Austria

27 -31 August 2018

The Secretariat of the World Trade Organization is organizing a Regional Advanced Trade Negotiations Simulation Skills (TNS) Course for Central and Eastern Europe, Central And The Caucasus Countries (CEECAC) to be held in <u>Vienna (Austria)</u> from 27 -31 August 2018.

The aim of the TNS Course is to enhance the negotiating skills of CEECAC countries' trade negotiators and deepen their understanding of how the concept works in practice. Participants will negotiate different modalities in Agriculture, Industrial products (NAMA) and Trade in Services in international trade negotiations and apply them to bilateral trade negotiations. This course is designed to provide participants with skills and knowledge concerning appropriate strategies and tactics for the conduct of trade negotiations, as well as techniques of systematic decision analysis for monitoring and managing the negotiating process. The draft programme for the Course and agenda for negotiations are attached.

The target audience for the course is trade negotiators, and/or other fairly senior level officials involved in trade negotiations and/or directly responsible for the formulation and application of trade policy instruments in the respective countries.

A selection process is put in place for all participants. Selected participants will be those: i) with very good knowledge in NAMA, Agriculture and Trade in Services. These participants would have completed RTPC or ATPC or face-to-face course (Geneva or Region) in any of the following subjects: NAMA, Agriculture and Trade in Services or, ii) who possess demonstrably commensurate experience/knowledge in trade negotiations. Completion of the WTO on-line E-Learning course on Multilateral Trade Agreements is mandatory.

You are invited to **submit names of two capital-based officials**, not only from the Ministry of Trade but also from other Ministries as well, for example Ministry of Agriculture or the relevant Ministry dealing with Trade in Services.
