

DICAM (Department of Civil, Mechanical and Environmental Engineering) of the **University of Trento** is inviting you to join Biennale Session on 6th October 2018. **The event will took place in the spaces of Arsenale of Biennale di Venezia 2018**. Four mediterranean universities (Pescara, Patras, Ancona and Trento) will exchange on the topic of **Emerging Resilience** through an exhibition of students' projects of landscape or building design studios.

Resilience has a very broad meaning, which comes from Physics, that is used to define a material able to return back to its original shape after a deformation. While referring to complex systems resilience is the ability of the system to react to changes to recover its functionality. The aim is to combine the different possible interpretations to new territorial challenges: **adaptively react to contemporary sudden changes**. **Presentation of Montenegro Pavillion** 'Jelena is back'

The program will include a meeting at Montenegro pavillion that is focused on the topic of resilience; its title being "EMERGING RESILIENCE. Reimagining voids through sharing values".
