The emphasis is on the academic excellence and inclusivity - delivering high-quality curricula in business, technology and compliance, languages and other fields, while offering scholarships to learners at affordable cost.

The Education Reform Initiative of South Eastern Europe ([ERI SEE](#)), is an international organization established by the ministries of education from Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Moldova, Montenegro, North Macedonia and Serbia. The ERI SEE mission is to facilitate and enhance regional cooperation in the field of education and training that supports national reform processes and connects the region to EU education and training trends.

Through the EBU's partnership with the ERI SEE, the EBU is offering scholarships for **high-quality online EBU programmes/courses** which are supported by the **Luxembourg Government**.

Scholarships are available to all learners aged 16 and over, regardless of their employment and/or education status. The Scholarship Programme includes, among other, the following courses:

The regular market value of the programs/courses offered is €740 per course; however, within this partnership offer scholarships are decreased to a commitment fee of €25 to €50 (paid via a credit card). The courses are provided in English, so the knowledge of English is essential. For those who need support with their English skills, English language programmes are offered within this scheme as well. Each program/course starts on **04 May 2026**, lasts 13 weeks and includes one online webinar per week, usually in the afternoon. All webinars are being recorded and can be accessed at the learners' convenience. The application deadline for all courses is **01 May 2026**. The application process is as follows:

**STEP 1:** Applicants are invited to register by completing a form available [here](#).

**STEP 2:** Once the online form is completed the EBU admission officer will send a payment request for the selected courses.

**STEP 3:** Once the payment is registered, the EBU admission officer will finalise the enrolment process. The applicant will receive an email with the login credentials for joining the learning platform and accessing the course on the student dashboard.
