Decision of the jury:	<p>The jury reviewed in detail 8 (eight) competition entries submitted electronically to e-mail address biennale.arch2020@mrt.gov.me until the deadline defined by the competition (7 February 2020).</p> <p>The jury decided unanimously that the most complete response to the Biennale's topic "How will we live together?" and to the demanding initial response "Towards a transactive spatial perception" was provided by a team of authors consisting of: Dr. Vasilija Abramović, Dr. Ruairi Glynn and Parker Heyl, with an entry titled "SYNTONY".</p> <p>The potential of the selected team to respond to the competition requirements is obvious in the competition entry and it is reinforced by the fact that members of the team belong to and participate actively in the production of advanced installations in the prestigious Bartlett Laboratory in London (Interactive Architecture Lab), which belongs to the lead global school of architecture and the built environment at UCL (University College London).</p> <p>The SYNTONY project represents a very high level of conceptual and technological maturity articulating application of a transdisciplinary methodology by integrating knowledge in the field of: architecture, art, neuroscience, psychology, robotics etc. Through the proposed spatial laboratories, focusing on an interactive installation, the aim is to engage a visitor in space by "experimenting with wave forms by using light, sound and movement". Innovative messages coming from the world of science and technology are interpreted through interactive moments. Authors of the project apply in their installation the most recent technical achievements (for</p>

instance, collecting data by sensors, their processing in real time, activating the installation based on collected data etc.).

Through this project, the topic of the exhibition “How will we live together?” can be understood as a symbiosis of life and technology, and intertwining of new knowledge in various scientific disciplines and everyday life. Finding the right measure and the choice of means will be a challenge for the authors in implementing of this project.


We are convinced that the team of authors is determined to advance this project in the implementation process in cooperation with the Commissioner and the Curator, and that the final outcome of representation of Montenegro at the 17th International Architecture Exhibition will remain permanently embedded in the memory of visitors of the Architecture Biennale in Venice 2020.

Conclusion:




