Transport Administration of Montenegro, hereinafter referred to as "the Employer", intends using the proceeds of an European Investment Bank (EIB) loan. The Employer now invites sealed tenders from Contractors for the contract: Reconstruction of national road M-2, section: Lepenac – Ribarevina – Poda – Berane.

The project is implemented in Mojkovac, Bijelo Polje and Berane Municipalities of Montenegro.

The works include:

- (i) earthworks;
- (ii) pavement structures;
- (iii) road markings;
- (iv) concrete and reinforced concrete works;
- (v) drainage and sewerage works;
- (vi) reconstruction of bridges;
- (vii) reconstruction of tunnel.

The estimated completion time is 730 calendar days.

Tendering for contracts to be financed with the proceeds of the loan from the European Investment Bank is open to firms from any country. The Bank shall not provide or otherwise make funds available, directly or indirectly, to or for the benefit of an individual or entity that is subject to financial sanctions imposed by the EU, either autonomously or pursuant to the financial sanctions decided by the United Nations Security Council on the basis of Article 41of the UN Charter.

To be qualified for the award of a contract, tenderers must satisfy the minimum financial and technical criteria specified in the tender dossier, which include the following:

- —average annual turnover: The tenderer shall have an average annual turnover as prime contractor (defined as billing for works in progress and completed) over the last three (3) years (2017;2018;2019) of not less than EUR 37 500 000,00 equivalents,
- —financial resources: the tenderer shall demonstrate that it has access to, or has available, liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means sufficient to meet the construction cash flow for the contract for a period of 4 (four) months, estimated as not less than EUR 3 750000,00 equivalent, taking into account the applicant's commitments for other contracts
- —experience: the tenderer shall demonstrate that it has successful experience as prime contractor in the execution of at least two(2) project of a nature and complexity comparable to the proposed contract within the last five (5) years, with a value of at least EUR 15 000 000,00.
- Specific experience: Participation as contractor or management contractor within the last five (5) years prior to the tender submission deadline in at least:
  - 2 (two) works contracts which include construction or reconstruction of the main, regional, express road or highway of at least 10 km total length each,
  - 2 (two) works contract which include construction or reconstruction of bridge of at least 30 m long, and
  - 1 (one) work contract which include construction or reconstruction of tunnel of at least 50 m long.

In addition, the following specific operation and works experience shall be demonstrated per contract submitted in order to fulfil the criterion, and values shall be at least equal to:

Excavation of material: 50.000m3
Execution of asphalt pavements: 50.000 t

The tender evaluation basis is the lowest price of the compliant and technically responsive tenders.

Remedy mechanism in line with clause 1.8.1 of EIB Guide and Appeal procedure are included in the tender dossier.
