Re-shuffling







Re-interpreting the linkage of solid elements.

Displacing and analyzing the possible route of imagination which will highlight the direct involvement of all the visitors.

As Zygmut Bauman remembers us liquid elements never mantain their proper shape, actually they don't fix the space and they don't link time. Since for fluids what counts is the temporal flux of space, for solid elements instead time is less important. Fliudity then becomes an element related to the flux in time and space. The flow of new forms of precariousness, both spatial and physical invites, then, the global society to reconsider the conventional ideas of borders, homeland and identity.

The intensity of the phenomena that the world is facing in the last decades is without precedents, for this reason in this concept-content first phase proposal we would like to focus on the necessity to rise questions and deepen the study on such territories of interpretation, to understand their geography in the process of changing within which it could be identified a new way of communication.



Super-imposition

How can a free space give a narration of a Country such as the Montenegro. It may be that in small surfaces dedicated to the exhibition some narrations could be sacrificed.

For this reason instead of a single statical representation, thoughout primary elements the project proposal generates single visions elaborated everyday by the single visitors.

Fluidity of changes and transformations will become the clockwise movement of this exhibition which will see the exhibition proposing an exciting path between lines of architecture that takes nature as an inspiration source.

The complexity of historical and cultural contaminations and stratifications in which we operate is the basis for a number of messages and codes that must read, interpreted and deciphered.





How will the visitor see the image of Montenegro.

Primary elements will get in contact with the visitors imagination and free to choose relationship.

Thus the visitor will become the real exhibitor of this event making the working progress attitude become the leit-motiv for a much more fluid combination. Thus the conceptual void of space based at the title of the Biennale will face a total interaction between what shown and what is perceived by the visitor itself. The project is unified and given homogeneity to both the fit-out and the vision through the design of the exhibition to which the flowing of people contributes to an harmonious and organic perception of the whole space.

The visitors' path along the pavillion will be segmented by insights over Montenegro's history of the country as well as its landscape and the future fit-out will set with the maximum attention a constructive overlay of messages which can find stylistic and architectonic analogies in nature's resiliency.

A great deal of attention will been given to the multimedia and didactic aspect of the exhibition layouts, adopting contemporary and virtual reality spots, interactive internet connections, touch screens and other technological facilities.
